### **Do I qualify for National Honor Society?**

1. Is my cumulative GPA 3.5 or higher?
2. Have I earned the Silver Service Award or its equivalent by the end of 1<sup>st</sup> semester?
3. Am I a leader in class discussion?
4. Do I inspire positive behavior in others?
5. Have I successfully held a position of leadership at school or in my community?
6. Am I actively involved in the Hill-Murray community?
7. Am I dependable and responsible?
8. Am I honest and ethical?
9. Am I able to advocate for myself?
10. Do I abstain from using chemicals of any kind?

Monday, February 6, 2012:	NHS application invitations will be sent home to all qualified juniors who have a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher and who have earned a Silver Service Award.
Sunday, February 12, 4:00 PM:	<b>Mandatory</b> NHS informational meeting Every NHS applicant and a parent must attend this meeting in order to apply for National Honor Society.
Tuesday, February 21, 2:30 PM:	Completed applications due to advisor—no late applications will be accepted!
Wednesday, February 22-March 7:	Faculty committee reads through applications
Friday, March 9:	Letters mailed out to applicants
Monday, March 19:	Last day for letter of appeal
Tuesday, April 24, 7:00 PM:	Induction ceremony for new members in Chapel
