# CO Safety Tips:


- Never run a vehicle inside the garage, even with the door open.
- Be sure your tailpipe is clear of snow or debris at all times.
- Any gas engine or motor, gas appliances, furnaces, and fireplaces are other sources of CO.



- If you experience nausea, sudden headache, sleepiness or confusion it could be CO poisoning. **MOVE TO FRESH AIR ASAP!**
- Check with your parents to make sure your home has working CO detectors.
