



Proposal for Hill-Murray High School

Background / Opportunity:

Donations For Education is a 501(c) 3 organization with a mission to reduce educational costs for students and families at Grade Schools, High Schools, Colleges and Universities. With our Volunteer Program, the primary source of Donations is from volunteering in concession stands at large sporting events like the MN Twins, Vikings, Wild, and U of M Events.

- We provide a very flexible sign-up process; volunteers pick their own dates -based on their personal schedules.
- This is a sensible Volunteer Program, with no risk or responsibility in understanding how to operate or balance.
- All busy work is done (scheduling, tracking individuals, month-end validation processing, group consolidations, scholarship checks and cover letters to Schools.
- A hassle-free process for School Administrators and Business Office Staff
- We have purchased the maximum insurance for volunteers (both General Liability and Liquor Liability Insurance)
- This is a proven, win-win scenario for all involved: parents, students, and school staff.
- We're happy to provide school or individual references –as needed.

Proposal:

Donations For Education is pleased to offer anybody affiliated with Hill-Murray High School (18 years or older), who is interested in reducing tuition, the opportunity to fundraise for 6 months during the entire 2012 Twins Season at Target Field (April 9th – September 30th).

Expectations / Rules:

- Volunteers need to be serious about this -with defined monthly goals of reducing tuition.
- The ideal volunteer is one that has some time and not a super busy schedule.
- A typical minimum number of events per month is 4, or about 20+ events per Season)
-The absolute minimum is 10 games for the Twins Season, those thinking less than this –will not be accepted.
- Volunteers that sign-up at least 30 days or more in advance of the event, will receive 90%+ of their selected dates. However, if any volunteer 'cherry picks' the easy popular days –like weekends only –they will not receive all of their dates. Also, anybody signing-up for events and then not showing-up without adequate communication, will be charged a \$65 No Show penalty. (Careful planning is required when selecting dates!)
- Those that can't perform tasks or take basic work direction or that have attitudes -will be eliminated immediately.
- Attending and completing a 3 hour Training class in the Twin City area is required -must be in Feb / Mar 2012.
- Scholarship Units are accumulated at all events, for planning only –estimate about \$50 - \$55 per event.
- Agreement to align with our processes is important –no exceptions. All volunteers must abide with our event sign-up process, report on-time, dress codes, attend required training, and follow rules in the concession stand.
- We reserve the right to determine where volunteers will be placed in the concession stand.
