



Application and Tuition Assistance for Hill-Murray School

A Quick Answer Guide to FAQ's for Families now at St. Bernard's School

We understand this is a difficult time for St. Bernard's families. It is our hope that as you consider your options for continuing your child's Catholic education in the Benedictine tradition for next year and beyond, you will find this Guide helpful as you consider Hill-Murray School.

1. Can I still apply at Hill-Murray for next year?

Absolutely. There is still room and time to apply for your family in all of our grades (7-12). We will waive application deadlines for St. Bernard's School families.

2. What's the first step in applying for enrollment at Hill-Murray for 2010-2011? How do I apply?

That's easy. Simply click [here](#) to complete our *Online Application*. If you prefer to do so by paper, just call our Admissions Office (651-748-2406) and ask for an application packet. Or, you may stop in and pick one up.

3. Is tuition assistance still available?

Yes. Grants are still available through the TADS (Tuition Aid Data Services) Process. If you haven't done so, you will need to complete a TADS form in order to be eligible for assistance. To complete the TADS form online, click [here](#).

4. Are scholarships still available at Hill-Murray for next year?

No, Hill-Murray scholarships have already been awarded for the 2010-2011 school year.

5. What if I have been receiving a scholarship from St. Bernard's? Can I still receive it at Hill-Murray?

It depends. We suggest you call the St. Bernard's Business Office and enquire about the scholarship you have been receiving and if it can be carried over. Also, many scholarships are offered by organizations independent from Catholic high

schools. Families from a variety of high schools apply for them, so you could be eligible for some of them, regardless of which school you attend. St. Bernard's is your best source of information at this point in the year.

6. Will my coursework from St. Bernard's School carry over to meet graduation requirements at Hill-Murray?

In general, this should not be a problem. Our course configurations may be slightly different and we are on a semester class schedule compared to trimesters at St. Bernard's. However, our counseling staff is ready to help make the transition as smooth as possible, and we are in communication with St. Bernard's Counseling department to aid the process.
