Performance Attire

Students are expected to wear the following to all concerts and events. Concert and Pep Band attire has been determined by the elected band student board. Please see Ms. Youngs regarding questions and band attire.

Formal Concert Attire:

Symphonic Band: All Black

Ladies: Below the knee, long, black skirt, or black dress pants worn with a black blouse. Your shoulders and back must be covered. Black dress shoes, skin toned or black nylons, or black socks. Gentlemen: Black dress pants, black collared long-sleeved dress shirt, black tie, black dress shoes, black socks. Please be neat, clean, and modest.

Concert Band and Middle School: Black and White

Ladies: Below the knee, long, black skirt, or black dress pants worn with a white blouse. Your shoulders and back must be covered. Black dress shoes, skin toned or black nylons, or black socks. Gentlemen: Black dress pants, white collared long-sleeved dress shirt, black tie, black dress shoes, black socks. Please be neat, clean, and modest.

Marching Band/Pep Band Attire:

Each member 9-12 will need to purchase a marching band/pep band jacket and polo. These jackets/polo shirts will become the students' responsibility. Students must wear their uniform in its entirety for designated schools events. In the event of inclement weather, students may be permitted to wear additional clothing under the band uniform. However, this additional clothing is not to be seen.

Marching Band ó Black Dress Pants, black socks, black shoes, and band jacket. (Pants must be *dress* pants. Jeans, sweatpants, or wind pants will not be acceptable) Dress in layers under the uniform for cold weather.

Regular Season Pep Band ó Jacket and Polo with pants and shoes of their choosing.

Students who do not wear the appropriate performance attire may not be able to participate in the concert or event. Subsequently, this may result in a reduction of the student's grade.
