Letter from the **PRESIDENT**

Dear Alumni and Friends of Hill-Murray,

Across the country, declining enrollment in Catholic Schools is a serious problem, with enrollment dropping more than 20% over the last decade. The reasons for the decline are numerous - from new charter schools and the closing of Catholic elementary schools (8 in the east metro alone), to the cost of access to Catholic high schools, and changes in the demographics of our service area.

So why is Hill-Murray the only Catholic high school to enjoy growing enrollment for the past four years? Archbishop Hedba recently posed this question when he was here to say Mass for the student body.



The answer is a "growth mindset" among our Board of Directors, administrators and staff that acknowledges the reality of the external challenges to access and excellence, and we respond with solutions.

Our alumni participation is growing and an Alumni Association rebirth is providing an institutional opportunity for long-time friends and acquaintances to reconnect and support the vision of the school.

Our annual giving has grown by 50%, supporting access for students from our traditional service area in the east metro.

We recognize that our students are immersed in a digital environment and that the educational experience we provide requires innovation, creativity, and entrepreneurship - all in alignment with our historical Lasallian and Benedictine charisms. We are earning a distinction as a destination school for students globally, as well as regionally.

Our outcomes are measurable. Last year 100% of the graduating class went on to college and earned over \$18 million dollars in college scholarships. Almost 40% of the class had earned 12 college credits while at Hill-Murray. Our average ACT score puts this senior class in the top 16% of their peers in the nation.

Our staff and students embrace a spirit of service. Remembering our heritage and the values of St. John Baptist de La Salle and St. Benedict, our students volunteered 9000 hours of service last year, preparing them to be servant leaders in the future.

My hope is that all alumni and friends of Hill-Murray help us rise to the challenge of access and relevancy by attending games and events, visiting our innovation center, supporting our efforts, and sharing the success of the school with friends and colleagues.

On behalf of our Board of Trustees, our Administrative team, and our Faculty, thank you for your support.

HILL-MURRAY GIVE DAY

The first annual Hill-Murray Give Day took place on October 17, 2017 with the theme "Good People Come from Hill-Murray." Designed as the school's unique take on Give to the Max, a popular charitable giving day in Minnesota, Hill-Murray focused on fundraising for sports and activities, theatre and the arts, and day-to-day school operations.

Hill-Murray encouraged donors to give using the hmgiveday.org website, which tracked donations throughout the day. Participants could donate in the morning and return later to help the school reach a new goal.

In addition, Hill-Murray Give Day featured 20 participation challenges to encourage families, friends and supporters to contribute. When each participation challenge reached a target level of participants, additional challenge dollars from sponsors were unlocked. All 20 challenges were completed, for a total of \$81,500 in challenge funds.

The Give Day committee promoted the event with a launch video and hourly videos on social media that featured alumni interviews, messages from past Ma and Pa Pioneer mascots and updates on giving challenges.

To showcase some of the more talented people who've come from Hill-Murray, our roving reporter also interviewed radio personality Joe Soucheray, Olympic-bound hockey players Hannah and Marissa Brandt, Children's Theatre Company actress Autumn Ness and recording musician Peter McKeown.

St. Joseph Scholars

The St. Joseph Scholarship is a need-based award given each year to five incoming ninth grade students. In addition to financial need, applicants must also demonstrate a strong work ethic and leadership qualities, and be active in both their school and community.

The funding of the scholarship is one-third donor-funded, one-third Hill-Murray-funded and one-third student-funded, in an arrangement similar to college work-study programs. St. Joseph Scholars work each summer, first at Hill-Murray and then in an off-campus position after sophomore year. Scholars receive job training, a Hill-Murray alumni mentor, and help with post-secondary planning. By requiring St. Joseph Scholars to play an active role in the award, the program helps to personalize the value of the scholarship, and strengthen the students' commitment to

earning a Hill-Murray education.

Growing up in the inner city of St. Paul in a working-class household, Bob Kranz learned early on about the power of education. Bob and his three brothers attended Catholic elementary and middle schools, and Bob went on to attend St. Bernard's High School and the University of St. Thomas. "My dad felt it was so important to get an education, and we believe that, too. We wanted to have a program that reaches students, brings them in to Hill-Murray, and gives them a path to education beyond Hill-Murray,' Bob said.

Bob and his wife Cindy chose Hill-Murray for their children and Bob joined the Board of Trustees in the early 1990s, during a financially tumultuous time at the school. With his expertise as an accountant, Bob helped to establish a new fundraising campaign, which enabled the school to regain its strong financial footing. Because of their love of the school and everything it offers to the community, Bob and Cindy chose Hill-Murray as a principal beneficiary for their estate. They created, and help fund, the St. Joseph Scholars program, providing kids in need access to private education.

Bob went on to explain, "Our hope was to get more students to come to Hill-Murray who could not have done so without assistance. But they need to have a stake in it and have drive. They need to have a spirit of volunteerism to pay it forward. In addition to demonstrating financial need, candidates have to show a solid work ethic, leadership potential, and be active at school and in their communities. We're committed to our investment in these students."

20 YEARS OF GIVING:

The Johnson Family Scholarship

After their children graduated from Hill-Murray in the 1990s, Mike and Jan Johnson wanted to give back to the school and the community. They focused on the financial need they saw in the East Side neighborhood where Hill-Murray resides. "Over the years," Mike said, "it became more challenging for middle-class and low-income families to afford a Hill-Murray education. The East Side was full of folks who couldn't go."

They established the Johnson Family Scholarship, which provides tuition support to families who couldn't otherwise send their children to Hill-Murray. The award requires recipients to be involved in school and community activities, such as sports, after-school clubs and volunteer work. The scholarship fosters leadership skills, a commitment to serving others, and prepares students for post-secondary studies.

Over the last 20 years, over 30 Hill-Murray students have had the privilege of being Johnson Scholars. Jan and Mike will never forget the very first student they helped. "Her family came up to us after their daughter's graduation at the Cathedral. They were so thankful," Jan said. "She was the first in her family ever to graduate from high school."

Mike hopes the scholarship inspires its recipients to pay it forward. "At some point, you're going to be in our shoes," he tells this year's Johnson Scholars. "I want you to remember that somebody reached out and helped you. Because there will be someone who needs your help."

Jan and Mike now live in Southern Florida, far from Hill-Murray, but they keep in touch with current and past scholarship recipients. "We like to hear how everybody's doing," Mike said. "It gives us a lot of pleasure when one of our scholarship recipients graduates. We look forward to seeing where these kids go."

The Johnson Family Scholarship has helped many Hill-Murray students over the last 20 years, guiding them toward graduation day and post-secondary plans. MEET FR. KEVIN MANTHEY

Nurturing a lifelong commitment to serve others

Caring faith leader, surfer, traveler, fluent Spanish speaker and talented drum player – all this and more describes the new Hill-Murray Chaplain, Father Kevin Manthey. When Jim Hansen became President of Hill-Murray in 2015, he made it a priority to work with the Diocese to bring a full-time priest to campus. "Having Father Kevin on campus full-time has been a blessing to the students and faculty at the school. Immediately, Father's presence on campus was felt - from daily Mass to opening doors for students as they enter the school each day. Father Kevin is great for Hill-Murray."

Father Kevin's journey began in Farmington. The oldest son of Jim and Ann Manthey, Kevin graduated from Farmington High School in 2005 and enrolled at St. John Vianney College Seminary, where he joined the Emmanuel Community. While in the Seminary, he spent a year in Belgium where he studied basic theology and learned to speak French. He also spent a summer in Guadalajara where he learned to surf and had the opportunity to fine-tune his Spanish-speaking skills. He received a degree in Catholic Studies and his Masters of Divinity at the University of St. Thomas. Following his ordination in 2014, he was assigned to St. Stephen's Church in Anoka as an associate pastor working with the Latino ministry, the grade school students, and the greater parish community.

In May 2017, Father Kevin received a call from the bishop about an opportunity to join Hill-Murray School. He met with Jim Hansen, toured the school, loved the community and made the decision to come on board as the permanent Chaplain. Father Kevin considers this scripture passage the motto for his mission at Hill-Murray, "That you may know the love of Christ, which surpasses knowledge." Ephesians 3:19

"Since day one, I have been impressed by the generosity of the staff - how welcoming and fun they have been. It has been exciting to learn about the Campus Ministry team and their incredible work with service, peer ministry and liturgies," Father Kevin said. "While on retreat at St. Johns University, I was blown away by the testimony of faith shared by the student peer ministers. The entire experience at Hill-Murray has been positive and I thank the Lord for calling me to this amazing community. As I look forward, I am excited to help students love Jesus, serve one another and grow in their faith."





PIONEER PATHWAYS

Providing Enrichment for Parish Schools

The Pioneer Pathways Program provides parish schools across the Twin Cities metro area with curriculum, experienced faculty and classroom assets in music, fine arts, world languages, STEM, technology and physical education.

Originally known as the Hill-Murray Parish Band Program, this outreach started 36 years ago, when Hill-Murray Principal and band director, Frank Asenbrenner, saw Hill-Murray as part of a school district with Catholic parishes. We have embraced Asenbrenner's vision of providing a more cohesive, enriching educational environment for parochial students of any age and created the Pioneer Pathways Program.

MUSIC AND MORE

In the early years, the program focused exclusively on music, which was Asenbrenner's expertise. Over the years, the program has evolved and expanded. Currently, the Pioneer Pathways program has 21 local school partners, with over 1,000 students enrolled. It connects Hill-Murray to the broader community and introduces young students to Hill-Murray as they consider where they are going to attend high school.







In addition to band and orchestra, art, physical education, STEM, technology and world languages, Pioneer Pathways gives students opportunities to participate in experiences they would not otherwise have had.

Music remains the heart of Pioneer Pathways, and for good reason. Studies have shown a strong link between playing an instrument and better performance in math, engineering and science. By offering students music education, along with other enrichment curriculum, Hill-Murray Pioneer Pathways is helping to enhance their overall academic experience.

SUPPORT THE GROWING PIONEER PATHWAYS PROGRAM

The Hill-Murray Pioneer Pathways Program continues to grow and welcomes the chance to meet with additional partner schools that are interested in enrichment curriculum and faculty. Aligned Learning connects Hill-Murray School to the broader community through Pioneer Pathways, Pioneer Summer and Pioneer Lifelong. Providing educational opportunities through partner schools, summer enrichment, and adult education, Aligned Learning serves over 1000 students each year.



St. Jude of the Lake: A Pioneer Pathways partner school

St. Jude of the Lake is a small parish school located in Mahtomedi with 43 students in Kindergarten through fifth grade, and 100 children in preschool. St. Jude of the Lake has partnered with Hill-Murray Aligned Learning to offer classes in band, art, Spanish and physical education.

"We couldn't afford this on our own," says Carrie Hackman, Principal of St. Jude of the Lake. "If we did find someone to teach part-time, it wouldn't be the quality that Hill-Murray teachers provide." Hackman notes that for a school that only needs a music or fine arts teacher for a few hours a week, it would be difficult to find talented educators with those specialties if not for this Hill-Murray program.

Hackman shares that the Pioneer Pathways classes have made St. Jude of the Lake more attractive to prospective parents, which helps to encourage enrollment. Hackman says, "It has been a gift and a blessing to tap into the Hill-Murray Aligned Learning resource."





Born in Senegal and raised in Cote D'Ivorie in West Africa, the values Simbo N'daive's parents instilled in him have been the driving force behind his work as a teacher and soccer coach. "My parents taught me to believe in myself and to use my skills and gifts to the best of my ability," he said. He has applied this axiom in his life and asks his players and students to do the same.

Simbo moved to the United States and in 2003 attended St. Mary's University where he received his Masters in Curriculum and Instruction. "I pursued a degree in teaching because of a conversation with my wife," he said. "She made me see the importance of making a difference in children's lives by being part of their education process. She made me realize that I was blessed with the gift of helping others through education and coaching." In 2007 he joined Hill-Murray Math Department and currently teaches Algebra I and II and AP Statistics to high school students. He explained how being a teacher helps him on the soccer field, "I understand the student athletes. I am able to connect with them individually and I understand that each player learns in their own way."

Simbo fell in love with the game of soccer at an early age, because it taught him how to problem solve which has served him well on the field and in the classroom. As his playing days came to a close, he jumped at the opportunity to coach and he became the Hill-Murray Varsity Girls soccer coach in 2013. His passion and commitment to the program has ensured sustained success.

"My favorite coaching moment came in 2013 when we played South St. Paul for the section final, "N'daiye said. "The game was hard fought and went in to double overtime. Late in the second overtime, one of our girls broke away and I knew she was going to score. Before the ball even hit the back of the net, I was on my knees with my arms in the air."

He has truly enjoyed his time here as a coach and teacher. "Hill-Murray is a special place with great kids," he said. "The students believe in the saying that all people should be known, loved and respected. A typical Hill-Murray student will go above and beyond to help others in need and that's what is so special about this place."



NATIONAL MERIT SCHOLAR

When Frannie Marin talks about about attending Hill-Murray and graduating in 2017, she speaks from the heart. "I was into everything at Hill-Murray," she fondly recalls. "I played volleyball my first two years and then it was theatre 24/7 for me, and I wanted to be part of every production. I was also in French Club, the National Honor Society and LINK Crew."

Frannie says one of the things she misses most about Hill-Murray is being a Peer Minister – she loves that the school emphasized service opportunities, including mission trips like the ones she took to the White Earth Reservation. "Hill-Murray has such a focus on service, and that has really inspired me."

With a top score on the PSAT, Frannie was selected as a National Merit finalist. After completing an essay and application for the highly competitive Merit Scholarship, Frannie was named a National Merit Scholar. She is studying Biology and Technical Writing/ Communications at the University of Minnesota in Minneapolis, benefitting from a \$15,000 scholarship that is renewable annually.

Although this is her first year in college, Frannie is already considered a sophomore because she earned 40 college credits through Advanced Placement (AP) and College in the Schools (CIS) classes at Hill-Murray. "I believe that everyone at Hill-Murray helped set me up for success by encouraging me to be ambitious," explains Frannie. "I only had one class that wasn't AP or CIS my senior year, and the teachers told me to go for it if I thought I could handle it. The motivation to push myself that I developed in high school is really helping me here at the U of M."

Frannie's National Merit Scholarship total is part of the \$18.2 million in college scholarships awarded to the Hill-Murray graduating class of 2017.

In 1989, Ed Flaherty established the Flaherty Family Foundation, which funded many endeavors including education. During the Foundation's first 20 years, Ed chose a small number of about 100 students, to establish a program of scholarship for high performing 9-12 graders into faith based, college prep high schools. Three years ago, his daughter, Beth Flaherty, took the leadership role as Executive Director of the Flaherty Family Foundation to formalize, grow, and implement a rigorous, academic and character based merit program of mentorship and opportunity. Our Flaherty Scholars are a culturally diverse group of students chosen through a stringent application process that encompasses academic standing, grit, exemplary character traits, and family economic challenge. Presently there are just under 300 Flaherty Scholars that study in 32 faith-based, college prep private high schools in Minnesota, Baltimore, Maryland, Washington, D.C., Great Falls, Montana, and a few other locations across the country. Currently, there are 20 Flaherty Scholars at Hill-Murray.

"We invest in these students because we believe in the them and expect greatness from them," explains Beth. "We expect them to be a shining light in their communities: school, home, worship, sports, and all other places where they have influence." She goes on to express the expectation that each Flaherty Scholar do, as Ed did so long ago, to look for ways to positively impact humanity by doing service and giving back both now and when they become adults. Foundation administrators work with the Flaherty Scholars throughout their high school years to support them in reaching their greatest level of academic achievement (a 3.0 GPA or above), to position themselves for college, and to take hold of all opportunities for enrichment and advancement. The goal is for 100% of Flaherty Scholars to graduate from a post-secondary program of study. "Success is the only option for our scholars," says Beth. The Flaherty Family Foundation realizes that for each Scholar, the relationship is going to span beyond four high school years of mentorship and encouragement. It is a worthy endeavor.


