

To aid in classroom learning, every student in grades 6-12 receives a computer to be used during their time at Hill-Murray as part of our 1:1 Laptop Program.

We use Virtual Reality as part of our curriculum to support lesson plans and we provide flexible learning spaces where students can gather to work on group projects, take a test or work on assignments.

SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY & ENGINEERING



Hill-Murray is proud to welcome Dr. Kaye Smith, Ph.D. as the new Director of Science, Technology & Engineering. Dr. Smith will be responsible for building an interest in STEM topics and careers among students - specifically addressing the drop in women choosing science, engineering and technology careers. She will oversee our current Technology staff and the Science Faculty, as well as manage technology outreach to the community.

Dr. Smith received her Ph.D. from Stanford University in Chemical Engineering and her B.S. in Chemical Engineering from the University of Wisconsin-Madison. Most recently, Dr. Smith was an Assistant Professor and Physics Department Chair at St. Catherine University in St. Paul. Previously, as a 3M Fellow, she led the University of St. Thomas STEM outreach efforts through a program that introduced sixth, eighth and tenth grade girls to the world of Science, Technology and Engineering.


GET INVOLVED AND FEEL ENCOURAGED To Take A Chance





ON-CAMPUS CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGIST



We'd like you to meet Dr. Julie Robinson, Ph.D., L.P. our new on-campus Clinical Psychologist. Hill-Murray is currently the only Catholic school with a Clinical Psychologist on staff who will provide psychological assessments for students with learning differences as well as other cognitive and psychological concerns.

In addition, Dr. Robinson will be available to identify and offer assistance to students struggling with mental health concerns. The staff at Hill-Murray recognizes the increase in anxiety, depression, and suicides seen in youth locally and nationally. Dr. Robinson will be working with Hill-Murray staff to screen for mental health issues, provide therapy or other interventions and to help parents seek out external therapeutic or medical resources as needed.

Dr. Robinson is available to consult with Hill-Murray families as well as families in the broader community by appointment.

ACTIVITY FEES

Students participating in athletics and most other cocurricular activities are required to pay a participation fee based on the sport or activity.

TECHNOLOGY FEE

As part of our HMConnected program, High School students are charged \$125 per semester and Middle School students are charged \$50 per year.

ENROLLMENT FEE

A \$500 fee is due at the time of enrollment.

TRANSPORTATION

Hill-Murray offers several transportation options to families. Students living in District 622 receive busing to Hill-Murray at no cost. 
