

Middle School Orientation is MANDATORY for ALL MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENTS, INCLUDING THOSE WHO ATTENDED HILL-MURRAY IN THE PAST. We want Orientation Day to be focused on community building, even during this unprecedented time of COVID-19. As our middle school continues to grow, the WEB Leaders, a group of Hill-Murray 10th and 11th graders, are excited to meet the middle school students, walk them through that first day, and answer any of their questions, and plan fun events for them throughout the school year!

Please arrive on time, as it is crucial for the whole flow of the day's activities. Please drop off your child at the front entrance of the school. There will be an outdoor check-in at the main doors leading to the entrance of the school. **Students are REQUIRED to wear a mask!** The masks worn **must** be plain or have the Hill-Murray Logo on it. Excused absences are absences caused by illness, family emergency, or trips that have been pre-approved by the Office of Student Life.

Parents/guardians are asked to call the **Attendance Hotline** (651-748-2250) before 7:30am on the day the student will be absent. Upon returning to school, the **student must present a note** to the Office of Student Life that explains the reason for the student's absence. The note must be signed and dated by the parent/guardian. **Failure to return a signed note the day after an absence may result in a 30-minute detention**.

HILL-MURRAY ATTENDANCE, CONTINUED...

Early dismissal requests should be submitted to the Office of Student Life *before* 7:55am. Parental permission in the form of a note is required. The request must include the student's name, the date, the time of dismissal, and the specific reason for the student's absence.

The Office of Student Life will not accept phone calls for early dismissals.



HILL-MURRAY UNIFORM POLICY

Shirts - White, green or black knit polo shirt with Hill-Murray logo, long-sleeve or short sleeve.

Sweatshirt/Sweater (Optional) – Black or green Hill-Murray monogrammed sweatshirt, long sleeved cardigan, vest or V-neck sweater. Students may wear Hill-Murray apparel, including team or activity sweatshirts or jackets or Hill-Murray Spirit wear that has been purchased from the Pioneer Trading Post, Donald's Uniform or Dennis Uniform. A collared uniform shirt must be worn under a sweatshirt, sweater or jacket. **Team or activity T-Shirts (long or short sleeved) may not be worn.**

Pants/Skirts – Gray or black uniform slacks for men or women. Gray uniform skirts for women. Skirts are to be worn at an appropriate/modest length. Skirts are not to be rolled at the waist.

Shorts - Black uniform shorts for men or women.

HILL-MURRAY UNIFORM POLICY, CONTINUED...

Shoes - Solid black leather or suede, casual soft-soled shoes are to be worn with uniform pants and skirts. Boots, sandals or clogs are not to be worn with uniform pants or skirts. Tennis shoes in shades of white, black or gray are acceptable with all uniform combinations including shorts, dress pants or skirts. Logos in shades of white, black or gray are allowed on the tennis shoes, any other colors are not allowed. **High tops are not allowed.** Shoelaces should match the color of the shoe.

Belts - Every student wearing slacks or shorts with belt loops is required to wear a black leather belt.

Socks - Black or white socks must be worn with pants. Women may wear plain white or black socks with skirts. Solid black, gray or white tights are allowed. Socks with small manufacturer's logos are allowed, as long as they are not distracting.

Note: All uniform items should be purchased at Donald's Uniform, except shoes or the accessory items listed above.

MASKS...SOMETHING NEW FOR ALL OF US...

Students will be **required** to wear masks.

Masks can have the Hill-Murray logo on it and must be a solid color in green, white, gray, or black. Students can wear medical masks or solid color gaiters in green, white, gray, or black. Please send students to school with two masks; one to be worn and one in a ziplock bag.

BACKPACKS!

New this year Hill-Murray will require a shoulder-based backpack, so students do not need to go to their lockers between classes. Students should have the necessary supplies for their classes in their bags at all times.



STUDENT PARKING PERMIT INFORMATION



All students who are interested in driving to school must complete the Parking Permit Registration Form on the next slide and bring it with them to Business Days on August 11 or 12 or Orientation. All information listed on the form must be completed before you are issued a permit. **The parking permit fee is \$155.00** and can be paid via tuition, cash or with a check made out to Hill-Murray School.

In general, priority for parking permits is determined by grade level, beginning with seniors. Other factors considered are driving distance to school, access to busing, employment, carpool arrangements and after school cocurricular activities.

Students will be issued a permit for the student lot and this permit must be displayed in the window of the car. Students who miss Business Days can stop in the Office of Student Life during the first week of school to drop off their Parking Permit Registration Form.

HILL-MURRAY LUNCH/TAHER INFORMATION



Taher food service manages our school lunch program. Each new incoming student automatically gets set up with an account.

Parents can view the account and make online payments by going to www.hill-murray.org, choose the parents tab at the top of the page, and then the cafeteria tab. On that page, you will find Wordware, the program used in the cafeteria. You can sign up for an account where you can see the balance, date, and amount of your last payment and the purchases by each student in your family for the past ten days. You can also sign up to receive a weekly email with your balance.

To sign up for the first time, you will need a Family Key Code. You need to contact the food service department to get this information. You may reach them at tahermanager@hill-murray.org You will receive two emails- one from Taher with your Family ID and one from Wordware with your Family Key Code and instructions.

You will also find eFunds, and this is the online service for making payments. There is a fee for this service. To Sign up, you will need a Family ID. You need to contact the food service department to get this information. You may reach them at tahermanager@hill-murray.org. This year we are asking to make payments to your lunch account online, please.

Lunch accounts must have money in them to be used. No exceptions!

TAHER INFORMATION CONTINUED...



A menu will be sent out each month.

From August 19- September 4, there will be one lunch choice each day. After September 4, more daily choices will be added to the menu.

Lunches will include a sandwich, chips, whole fruit, carrots, and choice of milk or bottled water. The cost is set at \$5.25. See the next slide for daily choices for August and the first part of September.

This year each student will sign up by Thursday at noon for the next week using a Google Doc that will be sent out. The student will be charged for the number of meals that they sign up for each week.

DROP OFF AND PICK UP PROCEDURE



Student Drop-Off & Pick-Up Procedure

- The main (and only) entry point for drop-off/pick-up is the east access point from Larpenteur Ave.
- Drive west in the front lot to the "Primary Drop-off/Pick-up" location. Students will exit from the passenger side of your vehicle
 and utilize the sidewalks to enter school. Use the right lane to drop-off/pick-up and if needed, use the left lane to carefully pass
 the vehicle in front of you to keep line moving forward.
- You will have a single lane exit option to turn right or left onto Larpenteur Ave.
- If the line of vehicles extends down to the east access point, and vehicles are waiting, you will be directed further north where support staff will direct you to a turn-around location. You can then head south to line up for your turn to enter front lot area. This will help keep Larpenteur Ave clear.
- By heading north to use the turn-around, you can utilize the Athletic Drop-Off/Pick-up location (Near maintenance garage) or the
 2nd Drop-off/Pick-up location (see map) as you head south. You can exit using the east access point.
- There are no drop-off/pick-up options on the west side of our campus during AM & PM peak times.
 AM PEAK TIMES = 7:15am-8:00am. PM PEAK TIMES = 2:15pm-3:00pm.
- Before and after "peak times", drop-off/pick-up can occur on the west side as long as traffic flow patterns are followed.
- No cars are allowed in athletic area parking for drop-off or pick- up. The two options for that are by the corner of sidewalk by the Chapel or the sidewalk in front of the Stadium Plaza.

HILL-MURRAY FAQ'S



What are school hours? 7:55am - 2:30pm

When can students arrive? Students can arrive at Hill-Murray at 6:30am Students must report to the cafeteria until 7:30am. Beginning at 7:30am, all students must report to their first class of the day.

Can my child be in the school later than the end of school at 2:30pm?

Yes. Students who remain at school beyond the regular school day must be in the cafeteria, starting at 2:45pm or with a classroom teacher, coach, or advisor. The student commons will be supervised from 2:30-5:00pm on regular school days. Students who are not in a supervised area after school are subject to disciplinary action.
