OUR SCHOOL

Hill-Murray School is a co-educational, Catholic Benedictine college prep school serving grades 6-12 located on a 40-acre site in Maplewood, Minnesota. Hill-Murray High School was formed in 1971 by combining the traditions, facilities and cocurricular programs of Archbishop Murray Memorial High School (a school for girls founded by the Sisters of St. Benedict) with Hill High School (a school for boys founded by the Christian Brothers). A middle school was added in 1989 and our name was changed to Hill-Murray School.

Originally founded to provide Catholic education to students living on the east side of St. Paul and inner-ring suburbs, the school has broadened its demographic base. It now draws from a 40-mile radius, from Forest Lake to the north, Hastings to the south and Hudson, Wisconsin to the east. The current student population is 890 and approximately 80 percent are Catholic. In recent years, Hill-Murray has welcomed a growing number of international students.
