ROY T. RUEB SCHOLARSHIP

The Roy T. Rueb Scholarship is in honor of a man with great integrity who has unwavering faith in God and the Catholic church. He has given much of his time and talents to others - his generosity has touched the lives of many people. He continues to be passionate about showing God's love to everyone he meets, especially to young children by offering them a \$2 bill, showing them the words "In God We Trust" on the back of the bill, and asking them to pray for their parents.

Application criteria:

- Applicant must be a male student applying to attend Hill-Murray as an incoming freshman or applying for the renewable scholarship in their sophomore year. The student must be a practicing Catholic and be involved in church and/or campus ministry and be willing to work to pay for part of his education.
- Preference will be given to a student from a larger family.
- Applicant must demonstrate need as defined from the TADS application, completed by January 15, 2021.
- Applicant must submit an essay addressing the following:
 - a. The reasons the student wishes to attend Hill-Murray.
 - b. How the student will actively participate in the Hill-Murray School community - including campus ministry.
 - c. Examples of how he gives of himself in terms of his time and talents.

Amount: \$1,000 for a freshman, and \$1,000 for the renewable sophomore award.
