

To Parents of Students Taking AP Classes

If your student is taking an AP class (AP Calculus, Statistics, Computer Science, Computer Science Principals, Business, Literature & Composition, and English & Composition) they received a letter explaining to them the cost of taking an AP exam this spring.

College Board charges \$97 per exam with the state of Minnesota providing a subsidy of \$35 per exam for Minnesota residents. If you are a Minnesota resident, your cost is \$62.

The cost for non-residents (for example Wisconsin residents and International students) will be \$97.

For AP Business College Board charges \$145 per exam with the state of Minnesota providing a subsidy of \$35 per exam for Minnesota residents. If you are a Minnesota resident, your cost is \$110.

The cost for non-residents (for example Wisconsin residents and International students) will be \$145.

Exams will be ordered on November 15 for all students who said “Yes” to taking the exam. Once an exam is ordered, you have until the day it is administered to decide whether to take it.

However, the College Board still charges \$40 for any exam ordered but not used; thus the \$40 is nonrefundable past November 15.
