## **Our School**

Hill-Murray is an independent, Catholic, co-educational, college, and life-preparatory school serving students in grades 6-12. Rooted in our Benedictine and Lasallian traditions, we embrace the journey of each student and are committed to the growth and well-being of each member of our community.

Hill-Murray School was formed in 1971 by combining Archbishop Murray Memorial High School (a school for girls founded by the Sisters of Saint Benedict in 1958) and Hill High School (a school for boys founded by the Christian Brothers in 1959). A middle school was added to Hill-Murray in 1989. Hill Murray is located on a 40-acre campus in Maplewood, Minnesota with a current



student population of 950. Originally founded to provide a Catholic education to students on the east side of Saint Paul, the school now draws students from a 40-mile radius.
